# 2021 Water Rebates

#### LISTED BY AGENCY

Below is a list of agencies and cities offering rebates for lawn conversion and/or irrigation products. Due to COVID-19 there may be delays on responses.

## **Alameda County Water District (ACWD)**

Note: due to COVID-19 rebate programs may be delayed by 1-2 weeks.

#### RESIDENTIAL

- 1. New! Rachio Smart Sprinkler Controller Instant Rebate (for residential customers)
- 2. Rebate for converting their lawns to water-efficient landscape.\*

\$1.00/sq.ft of lawn converted. Please contact them through the link to learn more.

\*To be eligible for this rebate, customers must be pre-approved by ACWD, so please check with us first before beginning your landscape conversion project. Rebates are issued on a first-come, first served basis. Funding is limited.

#### COMMERCIAL

#### 1. Weather based "smart controller" rebates

Commercial and large landscape customers that replace their existing conventional irrigation controller with a "smart" irrigation controller may qualify for a rebate of up to \$30\* per active station.

See <u>Program Brochure (PDF)</u> for more information. Sites must be pre-qualified - Please contact us for more information about how to get pre-qualified. \*Rebate is based on the number of active stations of each existing controller.

Resources include multiple plant lists including those which are eligible for the rebate program.



## **Contra Costa Water District (CCWD)**

Rebate programs and associated inspections may be delayed due to COVID-19.

#### RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Lawn Conversion rebate

#### The rebate is \$1 per square foot of lawn replaced up to the maximum amount.

The maximum rebate for single-family residential sites is \$1,000.

The website has checklist and detailed list of restrictions.

#### 2. Weather based smart irrigation controller rebates

**\$12 per active (used) irrigation station (zone) up to 50% of the list cost of the controller(s).** One rebate per customer per address. Multiple controllers per address allowed on a case-by-case basis. Pre-approval required.

#### COMMERCIAL

#### 1. Lawn Conversion rebate

The rebate is \$1 per square foot of lawn replaced up to the maximum amount.

Maximum commercial, multi-family, and municipal accounts is \$20,000 per site.

The website has checklist and detailed list of restrictions.

#### 2. Weather based smart irrigation controller rebates

Rebate is to upgrade conventional controllers to <u>WaterSense certified</u> smart irrigation controllers only. \$20 per active irrigation station (zone) not to exceed 50% of the list price of the controller.

## **East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD)**

#### RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Lawn Conversion rebate

Up to \$2,000 (single-family and small multi-family homes)

#### 2. Flow Sensor/Meter - measures water use

Up to 50% off the total cost - up to \$200 per device.

#### 3. Irrigation Equipment rebate

Up to \$2,000

Equipment includes high efficiency nozzles, pressure regulators, drip irrigation conversion, self-adjusting controllers, irrigation sub-meter

#### COMMERCIAL

#### 1. Lawn Conversion rebate

Up to 15,000 (commercial and large multi-family properties)

#### 2. Irrigation Equipment rebate

Up to \$15,000 for commercial or large multi-family properties. Equipment includes high efficiency nozzles, pressure regulators, drip irrigation conversion, self-adjusting controllers, irrigation sub-meter



### **North Marin Water District\***

Novato service area has announced an Emergency Water Conservation Ordinance 41, taking April 1, 2021. It requests a 20% voluntary reduction in water use from May 1 to June 30 and mandates a 20% (Novato Service Area Wide) reduction in water use from July 1 to November 1, to be achieved with non-essential water use prohibitions. #### RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Cash for Grass

\$50 per 100 square feet of lawn area. Limited to total of \$400 for single family dwellings. Requirements include:

- Replace the regularly mowed and automatically irrigated lawn with California native low water use plant material (see District Approved Plant List or Sonoma Marin saving water partnership list).
- Mulch new landscape to a depth of at least 4 inches.
- Agree not to re-install irrigated turf in the project area.

#### 2. Water Smart Landscape Rebates

Rebate amount: 50% of the actual cost of District approved items, up to a maximum of \$100 for residential customers.

Equipment that qualifies includes:

- Drip irrigation systems
- Water pressure-regulating devices
- Check valves
- Multi-stream rotating sprinkler nozzles (for lawn areas only)
- Rain shut-off devices
- Mulch

#### 3. Weather Based Irrigation Controller Rebate\*

\$100 or \$30 per active station up to \$1,200 per controller, whichever is greater.

<u>List of eligible controllers includes: Weathermatic, ET Water, Rainmaster, Hunter, Toro, Rainbird.</u>

\*Note: does not specify whether it is residential or commercial

## **MMWD (Marin Municipal Water District)**

MMWD has adopted a policy that restricts water use throughout the district as reservoirs are now at historic lows.

#### 1. Smart Irrigation Controller Rebate - two options.

<u>Up to 70% off of Rachio 3 controllers.</u>
Discount up to \$100 off on any WaterSense labeled controller.

## 2. <u>Landscape your lawn - (LYL) Turf Replacement Incentives</u> - for residential or commercial Option 1: Rebate of \$1/square foot of lawn replaced

Customers are reimbursed costs based on receipts submitted for eligible expenses, which include sheet mulching materials, drip irrigation components, and climate-appropriate plants.

## Option 2: Free sheet mulch material (cardboard, compost, mulch) and delivery, plus a free irrigation conversion kit

This option provides all the materials necessary to remove your existing lawn using a sheet mulch approach, as well as a component kit to convert existing overhead spray irrigation to high-efficiency drip irrigation.

#### 2. Water Efficient Landscape Rebate

It offers water customers an incentive to replace your lawn with water-efficient landscaping and receive \$1.00 per square foot, up to \$1000 maximum.

#### 2. Water Efficient Landscape Rebate

An incentive to replace your lawn with water-efficient landscaping and receive \$1.00 per square foot, up to 5,000 square feet.

#### 3. Customized Water Efficiency Program

Financial incentives to water customers who meet certain criteria to upgrade their irrigation systems or other water-using.

## **Santa Rosa Water District**

Both residential rebates and commercial rebates for turf replacement, irrigation efficiency improvement, and rainwater harvesting.

#### RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Cash for Grass

\$0.75/sq. ft. up to max of 1,000 sq. ft. or \$750. Once for the life of the account. For more information and requirements.

#### 2. Irrigation Efficiency

up to \$100.00 max for pre-qualified equipment/hardware Equipment includes water conserving controllers.

#### COMMERCIAL

#### 1. Cash for Grass

\$0.75/sq.ft. up to max of 10,000 sq.ft. or \$7,500.00 annually. For more information and requirements.

#### 2. Irrigation Efficiency

up to \$1,000.00 max per meter for pre-qualified equipment/hardware Equipment includes water conserving controllers.

## Windsor

#### COMMERCIAL & RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. WEL (Water Efficient Landscape Program) for commercial and residential

Up to \$650 for commercial mixed-use meter accounts and up to \$2,500 for commercial dedicated irrigation meter accounts when you remove water thirsty turf and/or upgrade your landscape with new, water saving irrigation equipment.

Up to \$500 for residential or mixed-use meters



### Cotati

#### COMMERCIAL & RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Cash for Grass

\$1.00/sq.ft. up to max of 500 sq.ft. or \$500.00. For more information and requirements.

## Healdsburg

#### RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Lawn Conversion Rebate Program

1.00/sq-ft (max 5,000 sq-ft or \$5,000) For more details

### 2. Irrigation Upgrade Rebate

\$100 per eligible irrigation system upgrade and up to \$400 rebate per meter. Eligible upgrades: pressure regulating equipment, conversion to drip system, check valves, rain/flow sensors, irrigation sub-meter and weather-based and moisture sensing controllers (must be Water Sense Labeled).

#### COMMERCIAL

#### 1. Lawn Conversion Rebate Program

\$1.00/sq-ft (max 10,000 sq-ft or \$10,000) For more details

## St. Helena

#### COMMERCIAL & RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Cash for Grass

\$1.50/per square foot of turf grass that is replaced with low water use plants, drip irrigation or permeable hardscape.

Maximum rebate for residential is \$750.

Maximum rebate for commercial is \$2500.

#### 2. Smart Irrigation Controller Rebates

Up to \$20 per station for residential, maximum rebate of \$500.

Up to \$30 per station for commercial, maximum rebate of \$1500.

All controllers must have a WaterSense certification.



## **Yountville**

#### COMMERCIAL & RESIDENTIAL

#### 1. Cash for Grass

\$1.00/per square foot of turf removed with per site maximum of: Maximum rebate for residential is \$750.

Maximum rebate for commercial is \$2500.
